1 How to knit (Full needle rib) tailored collar

- ① Arrange the needles for the pattern as the diagram on previous page.
- ② Work the collar in the same manner as for the shawl collar. For the lapel refer to figure A.



- ③ After working the shaping by partial knitting, knit 1 row across all stitches.
- ④ Then using a piece of waste yarn, knit 1 row around on KH and KR by hand.
- ⑤ Leaving a loop of yarn about 30 cm long hanging down, knit to the right. Continue partial knitting of the increases as shown in the diagram. Decreases are worked in the same manner as for the shawl collar.

★ The looped yarn in 5 is used to finish the lapel.

- ⑥ After both sides of collar are completed, press the lapel only, very lightly with a steam iron. Unravel the waste yarn. The two edges of the lapel are separated now. Finish the decreased part in ribbing, and for the increased part, pass the yarn twice through the stitches. Block lightly with a steam iron in the shape of the pattern.

2 How to attach the collar

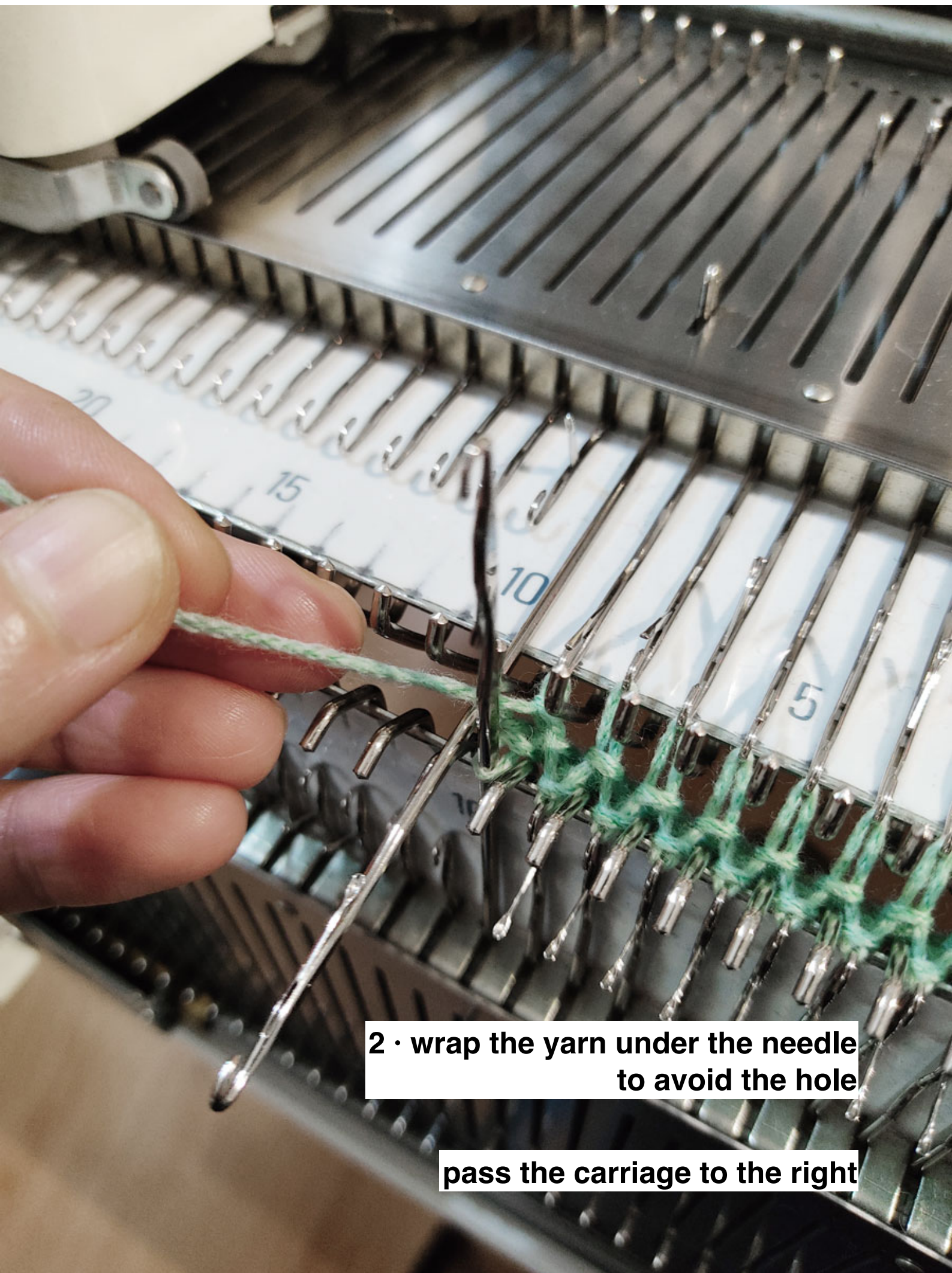
Do same as for the shawl collar.





**1• pull out the last two needles
and start shaping the lapel by partial knitting**

to avoid the hole**

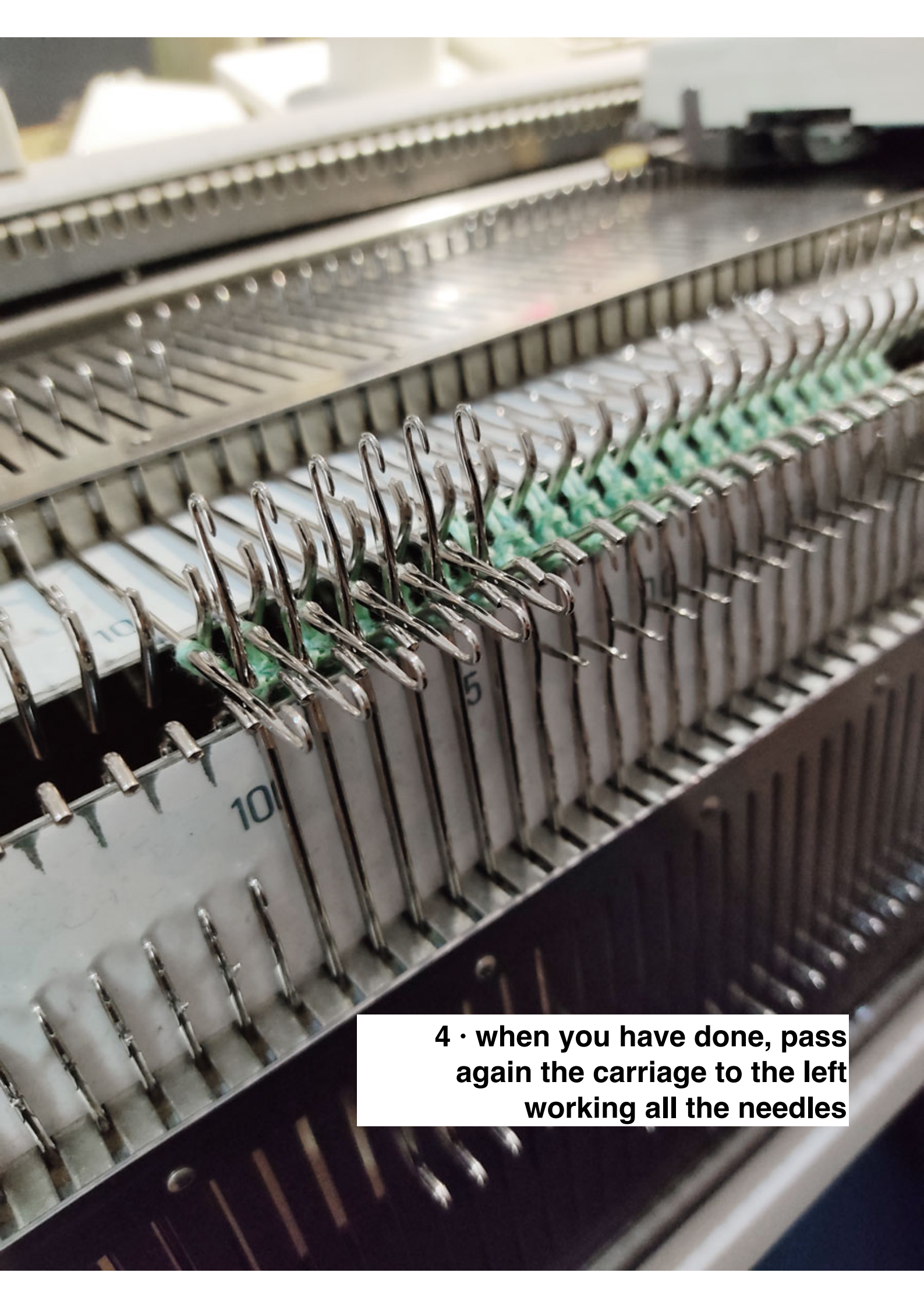
pass the carriage to the right



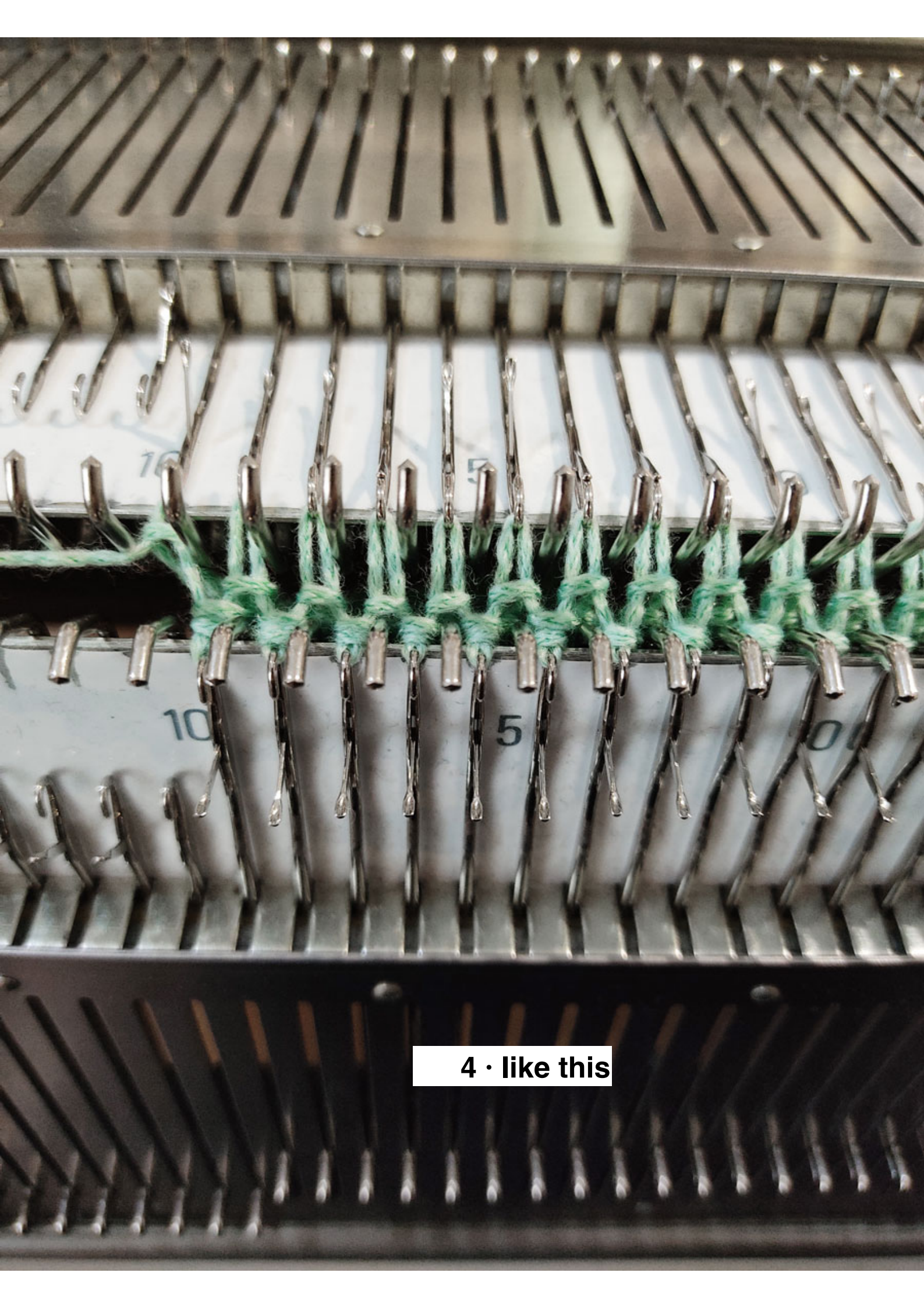
2b · this is how it looks



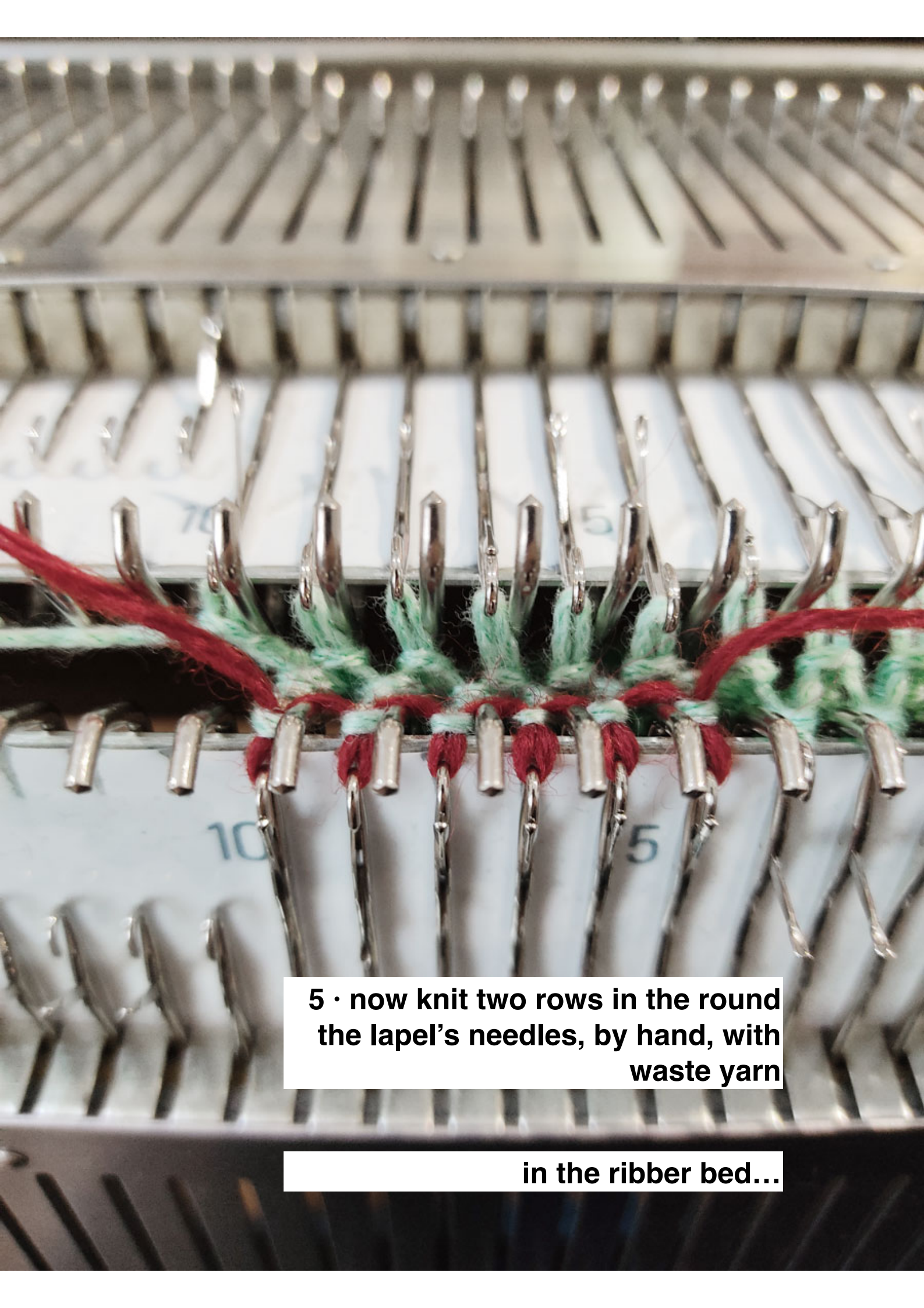
**3 · pull out the next two needles

working all the needles**

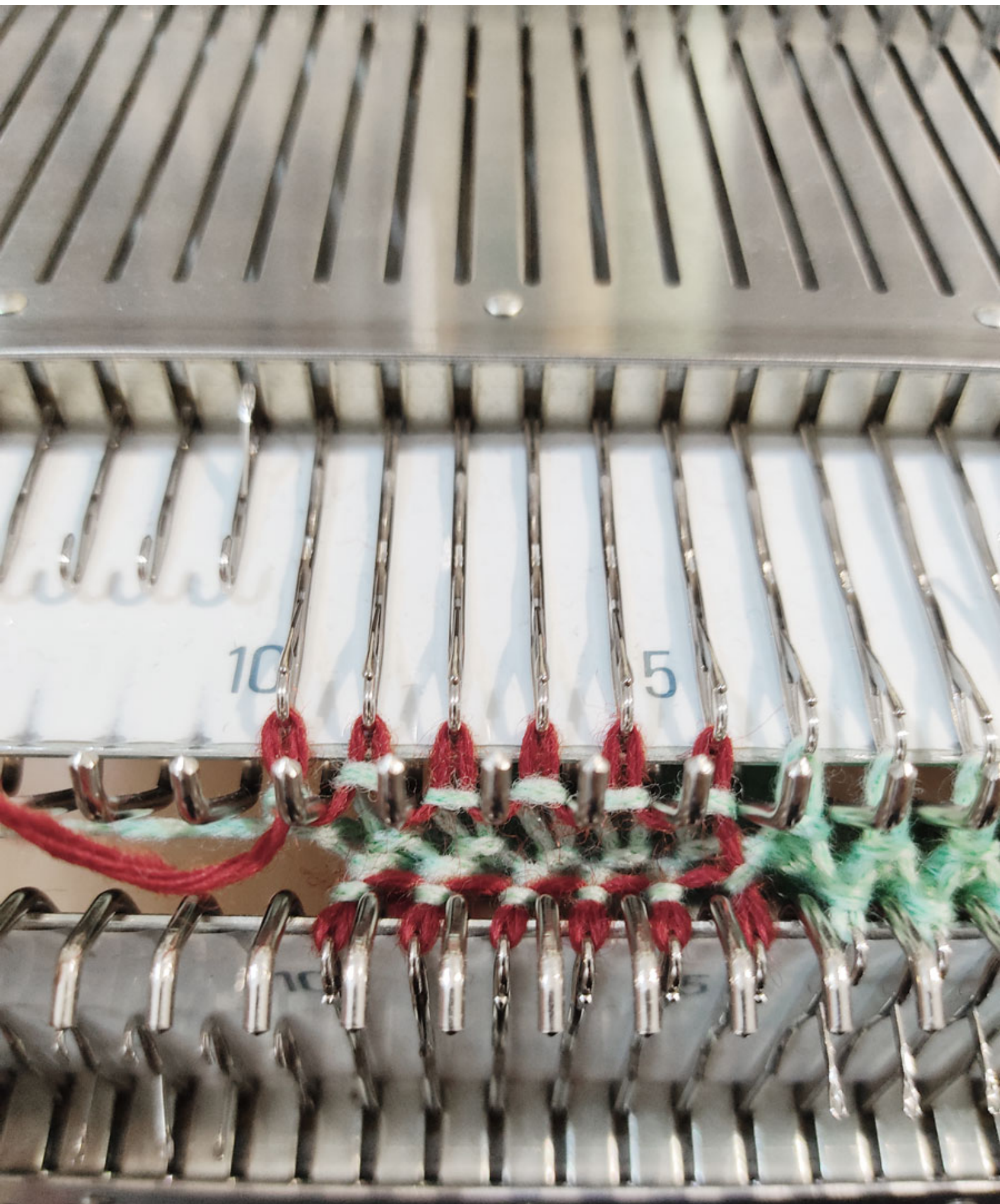


4 · like this



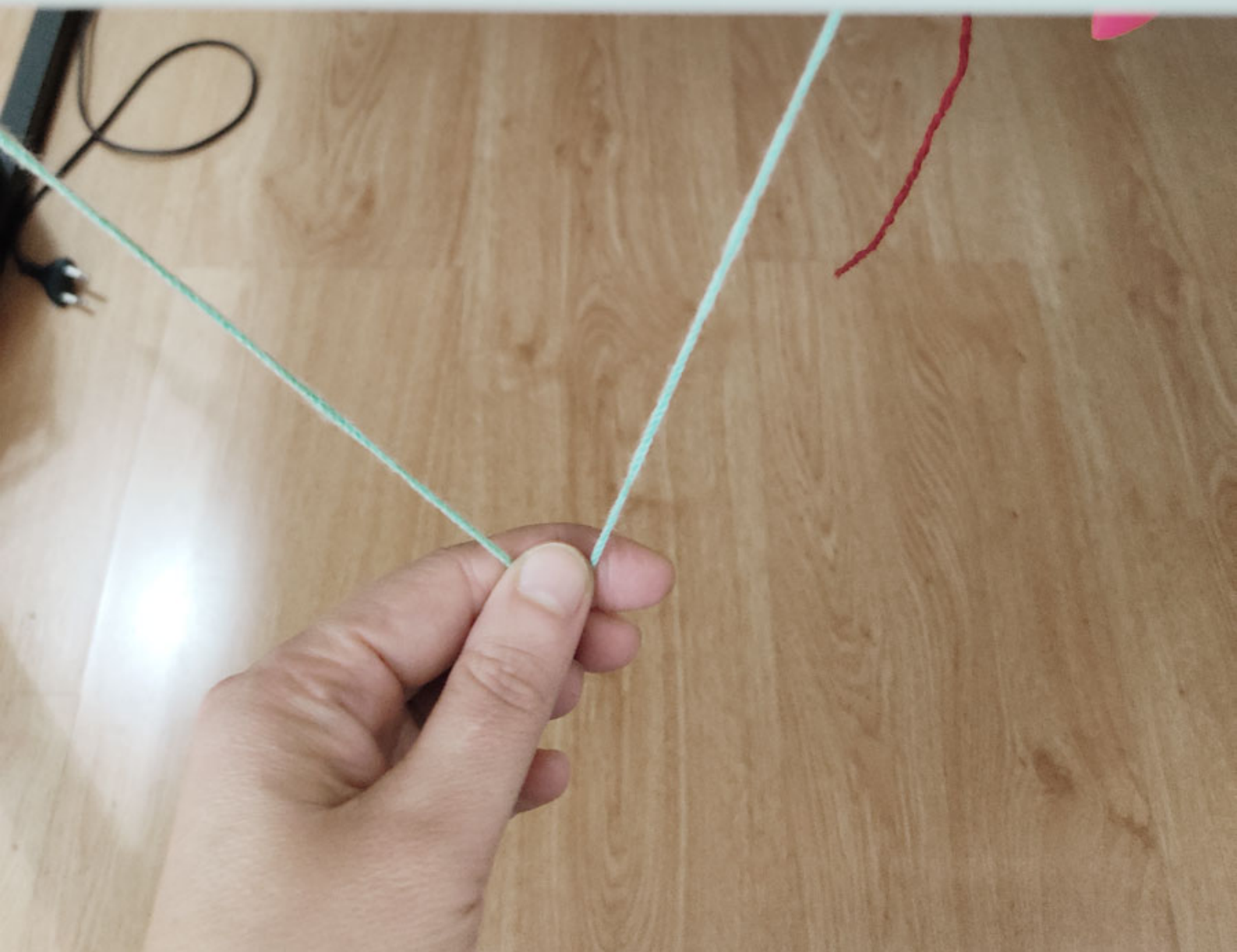
**5 · now knit two rows in the round
the lapel's needles, by hand, with
waste yarn**

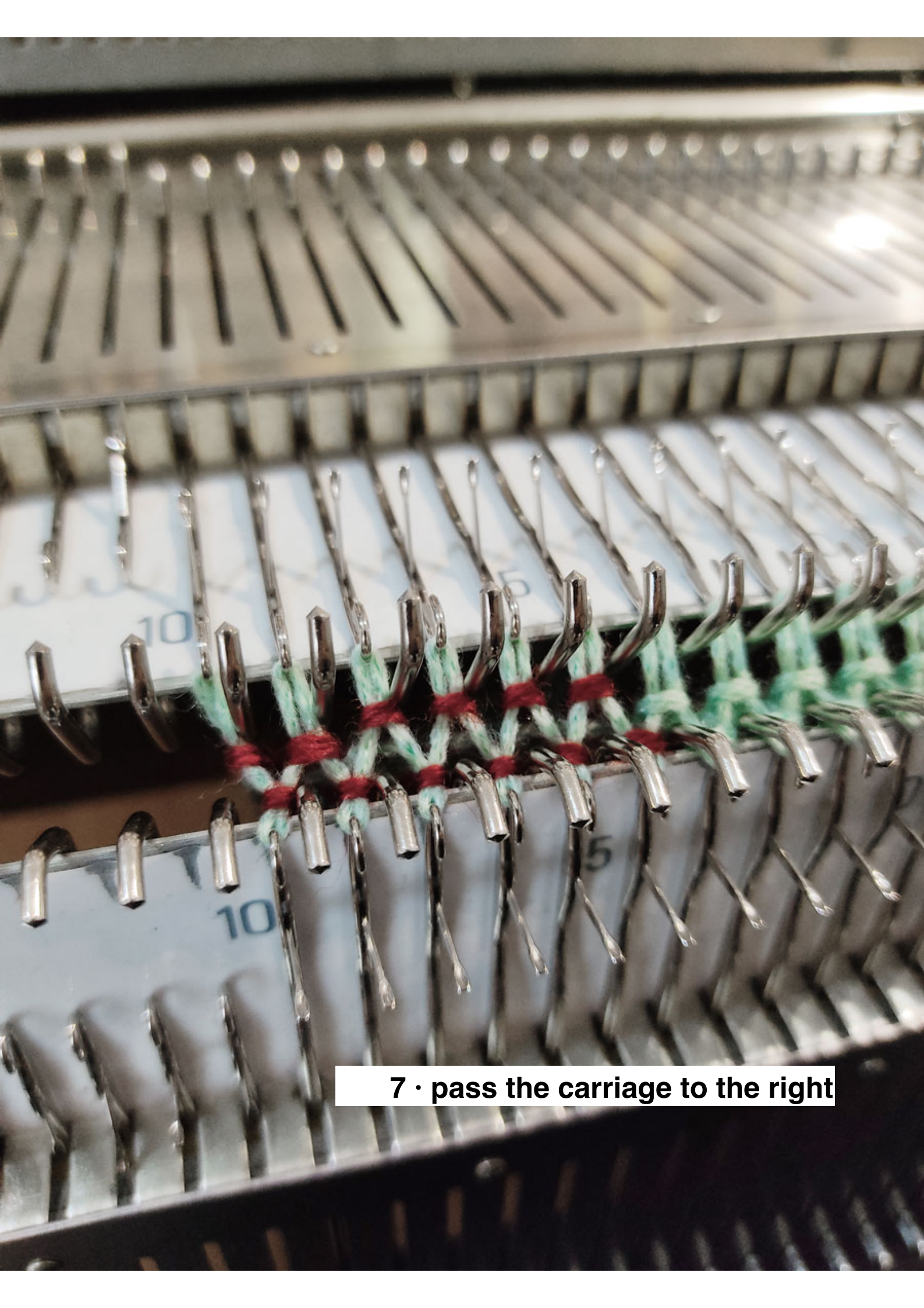
in the ribber bed...



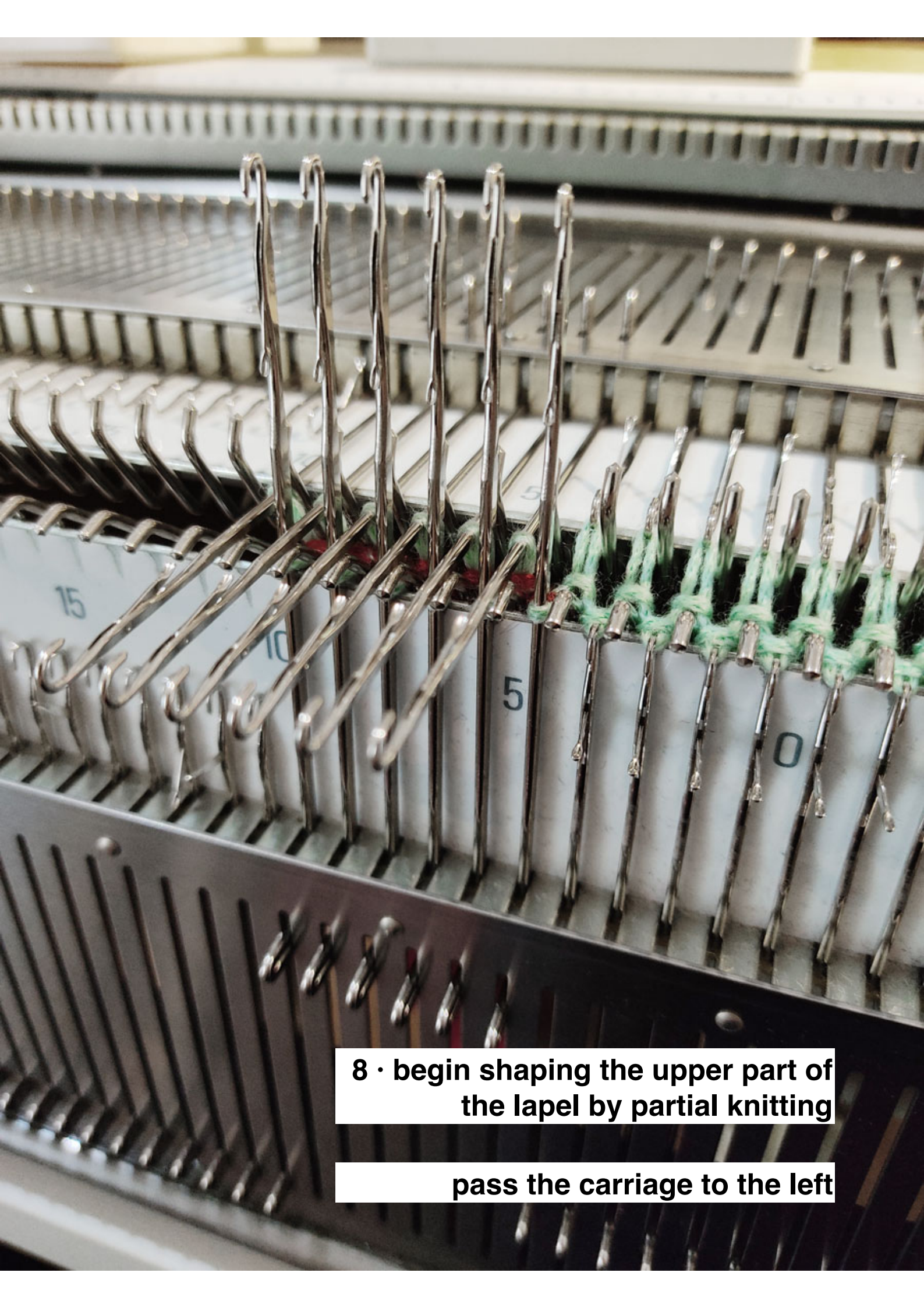
... and in the main bed

6 · now, before passing the carriage to the right, pull the main yarn down for about 30 cm: you'll need it for finishing





7 · pass the carriage to the right



**8 · begin shaping the upper part of
the lapel by partial knitting**

pass the carriage to the left



8 · wrap the yarn behind the needle again...

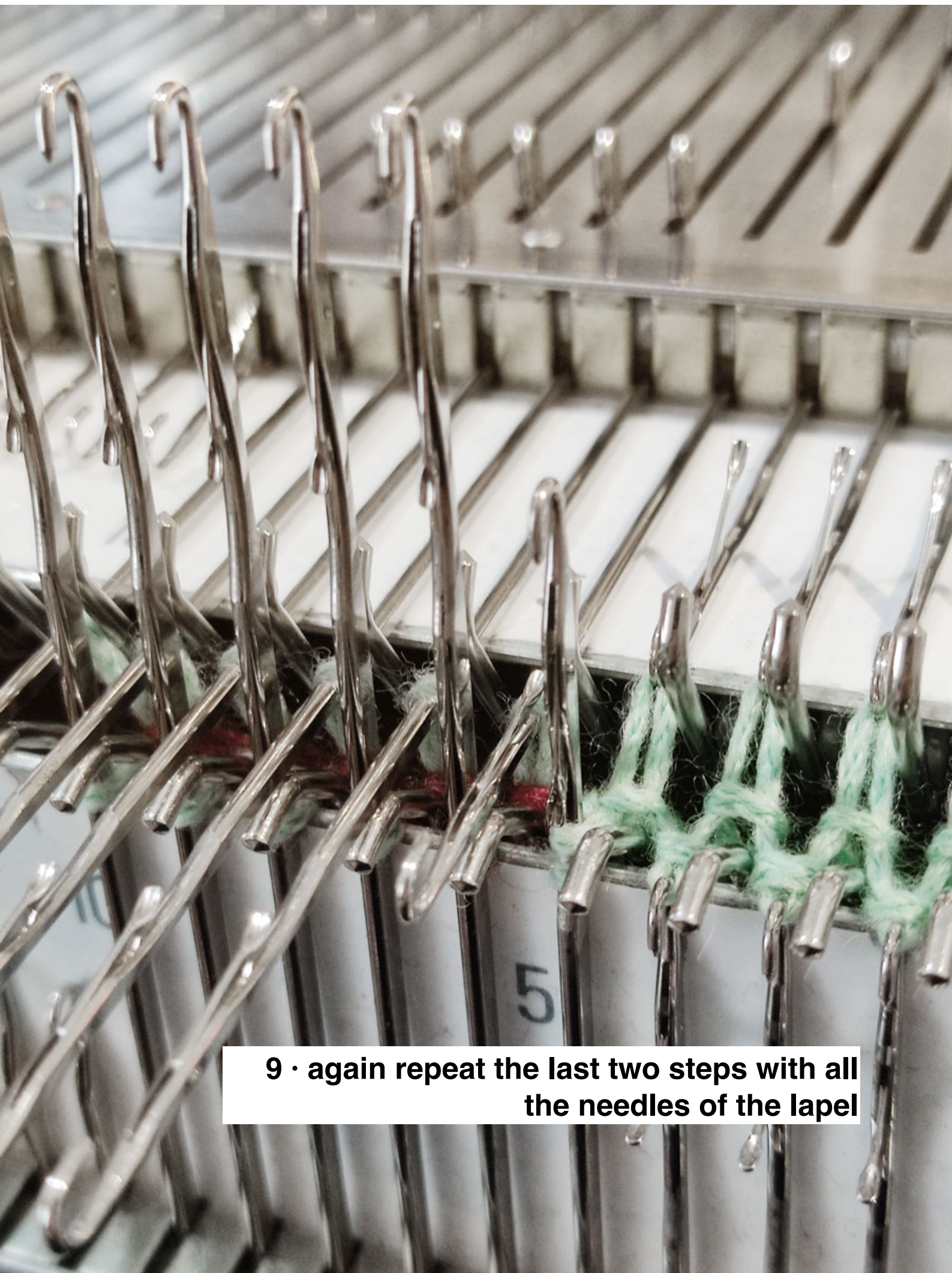


... like this

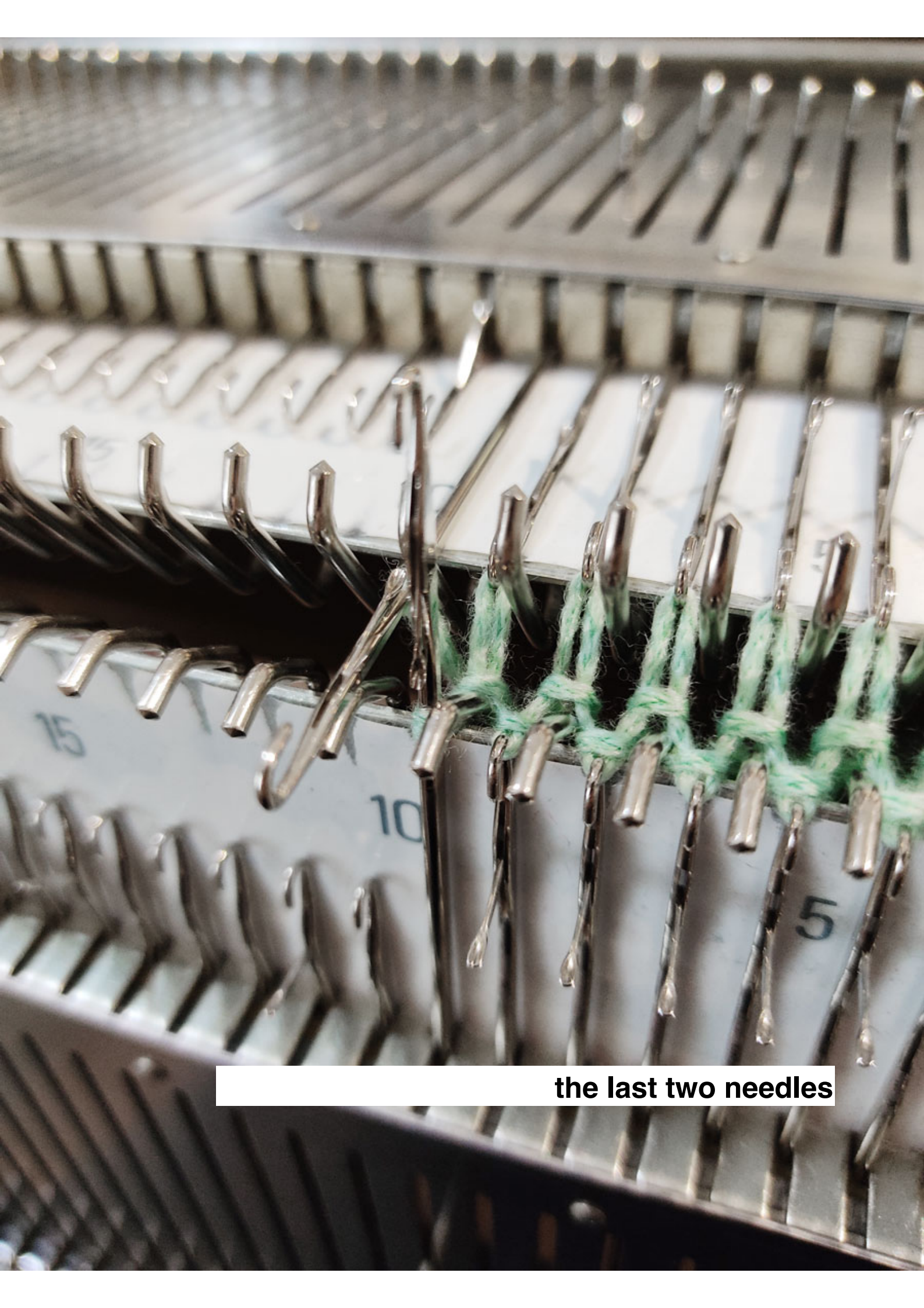
and pass the carriage to the right



this is how it looks



9 · again repeat the last two steps with all the needles of the lapel



the last two needles



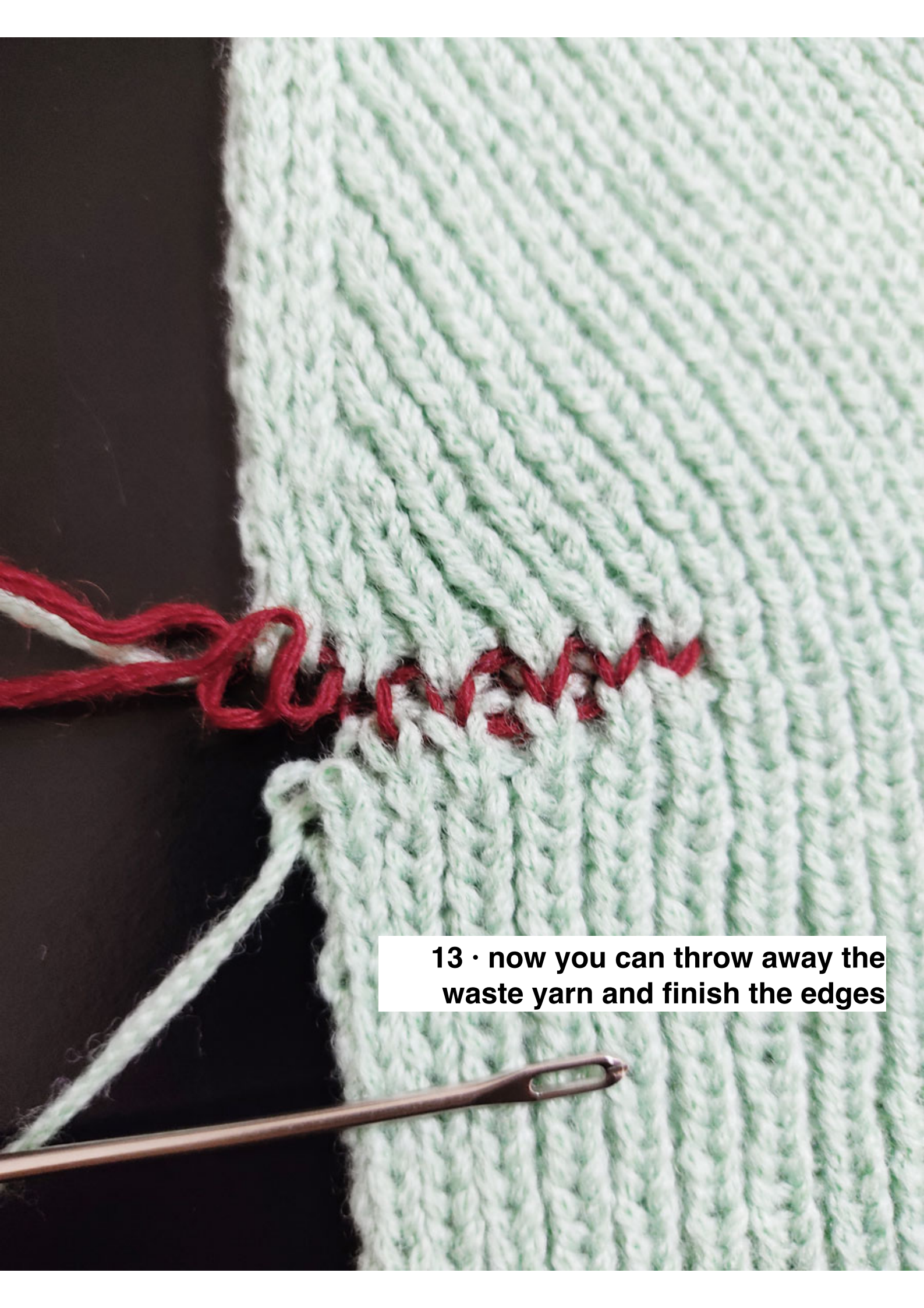
10 · now you can continue to shape the collar by decreasing with the transfer tool



11 · this is how it looks



12 · block the piece by steaming



13 · now you can throw away the waste yarn and finish the edges
